THE CONFERENCE

Centre for Facilities Management – Realdania Research (CFM) in Denmark invite you to participate in this unique event – a conference about Facilities Management (FM) research for practice in the Nordic countries. The conference is arranged in collaboration with NordicFM and DFM – the Danish Facilities Management Association.

The purpose is to create an exciting meeting place for people working with FM around CFM-research. The conference program is planned to give insight into research projects, to discuss the results and to explore mutual interests of practitioners and researchers in the next generation of FM-research. The ambition is to create a Nordic meeting place, which the participants will remember for the intellectual challenge, its practical relevance and as a milestone in the increased alliance around FM-research for practice in the Nordic countries.

Programme

The conference will include a combination of plenary sessions, parallel sessions and workshops. The speakers are invited by the organizers and come from Denmark, Norway, Sweden and Finland. The conference language is English, except the workshop on Research, education and practice, which will be in Scandinavian language.
